VOTE FOR CHANGES OF THE PROPOSED BYLAWS AT GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

The following summary of proposed Bylaw amendments have been approved by the Board for membership approval at the General Meeting on October 18, 2024

Section 1.06– General membership meetings to be held in April and October, instead of quarterly.

Section 4.01– Board director terms to be 3 years instead of 2.

Section 5.01– Officer term to be 1 year instead of 2.

Section 8.03– Eliminate restriction of only one member per family on each committee.
