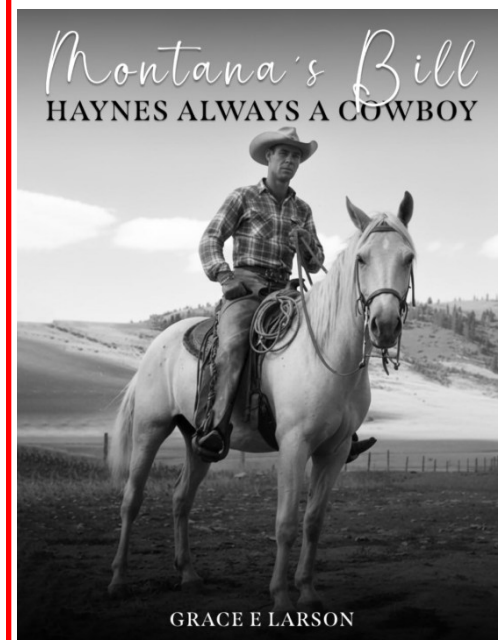


Special thanks to everyone who made it out to our first annual Chocolate, Cheese and Cracker Potluck! It was a big

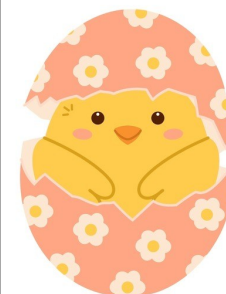
